Target of reform

Build an integrated health service system to provide health coverage for the whole society, population, and life cycle

Organization

31 community health service centers, general hospitals, maternal and child health centers, traditional Chinese Medicine hospitals, rehabilitation hospitals, geriatric hospitals, and precision medicine research institutes.

Prevention, health promotion, public health, treatment, rehabilitation, medical integration, and **palliative care to meet the health needs of the entire life cycle.**

Service content

The range of service coverage

Functional Social Health Stations are located in schools, enterprises, institutions, and crowded places (temples, high-speed rail stations). They provide services covering the whole population and the whole society to meet the diverse, multilevel health needs of residents.

Enhance individual and community empowerment and strengthen primary health care services

(I) Building and sharing, building a healthy community

Community-based, sponsored by the government. Organization of community residents and streets, community workstations and health, propaganda, civil affairs, education, and other forces that can be mobilized to participate in a series of scientific health behavioral interventions to promote the physical and mental health of residents.



Provide first aid knowledge and skills training for residents



Build a nutrition promotion supermarket and create a nutrition community

(II) Optimize resource allocation, make primary health care services accessible and convenient



Optimize the layout of the social welfare center. The residents can walk to the social health clinic from any location in the Luohu area in no more than 15 minutes. The average waiting time for the social health clinic is 12 minutes.

Increase the number of general practitioners. In 2018, there were 4.07 general practitioners per 10,000 people in Luohu District (2.22 general practitioners per 10,000 people in China).

Specialists provide technical support for primary health care services: excellent specialists set up specialist studios in the community.
